### Texting and Connecting: Developing Boss-level Messaging Skills Lesson Plan

- Demonstrate an understanding of how emojis are used in the target language
- Exchange information using texts that incorporate emoji

### Using Digital Games for Learning Lesson Plan

- Identify a digital game that can be played in the target language that they want to explore
- Keep a log of gameplay
- Reflect on what they have learned during gameplay

### Adapting Sentences in the Wild! Lesson Plan

- Identify whether each sentence is applicable to additional contexts
- Identify a context where they could use a given sentence and/or modify it to fit their needs
- Explain one way to change a given sentence to better fit their communicative context
